


RESURRECTION SUBJECTION

THE DAY THAT CHANGED EVERYTHING

Only a Look at Jesus Acts 9:1-9




- Some people today claim that they have seen Jesus (if they did their lives would have changed).
- The disciples saw the resurrected Jesus and their lives were changed
- Paul saw Jesus on the Damascus road and his life was changed.
- One day, all of us will meet the resurrected Jesus




- The resurrection of Jesus changes everything.
- This is because the resurrection of Jesus has three key truths that changes the direction of our lives.
- What you believe about the resurrection of Jesus will change the direction of your life.

Truth #1: Jesus Christ is Alive That Changes Our Outlook on Life

- The Resurrection of Christ means that His Death is significant.
 - His death did not discredit
 Him (He is not a liar or lunatic)
 - His death fulfilled prophecy (it was part of a sovereign plan NOT a messed up plan)
 - His death accomplished
 God's purpose (it provided redemption for mankind)






- The resurrection of Jesus means that Jesus Himself is significant.
 - He is the Son of God
 - He is Israel's Messiah
 - He is associated with the God of Israel (not with some pagan god)
 - There is an eternal future hope for those who believe in Him

Truth #2: Jesus Christ Provides the Only Means of Salvation—That Changes Our Outlook on Religion

- Now, all religious beliefs without Christ lay under God's rebuke
 - For Paul, Jesus of Nazareth could not be the Messiah because He got Himself killed.
 - Now Paul sees Jesus not only as the Messiah, but the one and only Saviour of mankind.
 - Jesus cannot be reinterpreted based on our personal agendas


Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:12)




- Now, all religious practices without Christ lay under God's rebuke.
 - Works of the law are insufficient
 - Religious rituals are insufficient
 - Religious holy days are insufficient
 - Religious traditions are insufficient

Truth #3: Jesus Christ has a Union between Himself and His People—That Changes Our Outlook on Service

- This is the basis for how we treat one another.
 - A bad attitude against even one of God's people is a bad attitude against Christ.
 - To abuse and mistreat even one of God's people is to abuse and mistreat Christ.





- This is basis for how we serve Christ
 - Paul realized that he had a mission to carry out for Christ
 - We too have a mission to carry out for Christ
