SEEING GOD THROUGH LOVE

1 JOHN 4:12-16

The commandment of God to His people is twofold:

- 1) To love the LORD your God with all your **heart**, with all your **soul**, and with all your **strength**, and with all your **mind** (Deut.6:5; Matt.22:37)
- To love your neighbor as yourself (Lev.19:18; Matt.22:39)

Many people <u>claim</u> that they: Know God Abide in God Have Fellowship with God Love God Speak for God Are in the Presence of God

Question: How can we know this for sure?

Big Question:

How can we be sure that the presence of God is real in our lives?





THERE IS REAL EVIDENCE THAT THE PRESENCE OF GOD IS REAL IN OUR LIVES



EVIDENCE #1: OUR LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER

"No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us". 1John 4:12

- EVIDENCE #1: OUR LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER
 - Principle #1: No one has seen God at any time.
 - God is Spirit. (Jn.4:24) ; e.g., Physical eyes cannot see Him.
 - The Old Testament Theophanies did not involve the full revelation of God (e.g., Ex.24:9-11; Gen.18:1; Ex.33:21-23).
 - The Lord Jesus Christ is the full revelation of the Father (John 1:18).

- EVIDENCE #1: OUR LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER
 - Principle #2: The evidence of God's presence and work is the love we have for one another.
 - Fact #1 : If we love one another, God <u>abides</u> in us.
 - Remember: Love is of God.
 - Remember: God is love.
 - **Remember**: Everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
 - Remember: Love is more than just an emotion, feeling or affection—it is a decision to act sacrificially and unconditionally for the welfare of another based upon that emotion, feeling, or affection.
 - Fact #2: If we love one another, God's love has been perfected in us (i.e., God's love fulfils its purpose in us).
 - Remember: God's love does NOT get better (e.g., God's love is perfect because God is perfect).
 - God's love fulfils its **<u>purpose</u>** in us in that we love as He loves.

- EVIDENCE #1: OUR LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER
 - Point: We cannot see God, but our love for one another shows that God is in our lives—His presence and work can be recognized and realized—and that is real.
 - Note: Many of us have been mistaken about the presence of God in our lives (a major trick of the devil).
 - Some think that God is present when they speak in tongues.
 - Some think that God is present in an emotional worship service.
 - Some think that God is present when things are working out good for us—when we are successful in something.
 - However, the Scriptures argue that our love for one another is the evidence of God's presence.

- EVIDENCE #2: OUR RECEPTION OF HIS SPIRIT
- "By this we <u>know</u> that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit." 1John 4:13

• EVIDENCE #2: OUR RECEPTION OF HIS SPIRIT

- Principle: A believer can <u>know</u> (without doubt or uncertainty) that he/she abides in Him (God) and that He (God) abides in him/her.
- Proof: The believer has <u>received</u> the Spirit from God (this happens at the moment of saving faith).
- **Position**: The believer's life is **<u>influenced</u>** by the Spirit.
 - Proof #1: They <u>believe</u> that the Father has sent the Son as Savior of the world (personal <u>acknowledgement</u> of the gospel truth).
 - Proof #2: They <u>confess</u> that Jesus is the Son of God (personal <u>affirmation</u> of the gospel truth).
 - Proof #3: They know and believe the love that God has for them (personal <u>acceptance</u> of the gospel truth).
 - Proof #4: They abide in love (personal <u>application</u> of the gospel truth).

CHALLENGE

Does God abide in you? Do you abide in God? Is the presence of God real in your life?

RECEIVE THE LORD JESUS CHRIST AS YOUR SAVIOUR TODAY!!



- Acknowledge that the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, <u>died</u> on the cross for your sin, and that He <u>arose</u> again from the dead on the third day.
- 2. Admit that you are a sinner, guilty of sin and responsible and accountable to a holy God for your sin, and that you are under His just condemnation and eternal punishment for your sin.
- **3. Affirm** that the Lord Jesus Christ is your Lord and Saviour by receiving His salvation through your faith in Him alone.
