

# LESSSONS FROM THE WISDOM PSALMS

**PSALMS 37:23-33** 

#### IT PAYS TO TRUST IN THE LORD

 LESSON: There are benefits to be enjoyed in this life for the one who trusts in the Lord.



## TRUSTINGLORD and do good; Dwell "the land and cultivate faithfulness. Delight And He will give you heart. Commit your way to the LORD, Trustalsoin Him. and He will doit. Psalm 37:3-5

- BENEFIT #1: A **WALK** THAT IS ESTABLISHED BY THE LORD (37:23-24)
  - Fact #1: The Steps of a Good Man areOrdered by the Lord.
  - -Fact #2: The Lord Delights in his (the good man's) Way.
  - -Fact #3: Though a "Good Man" Fall, He shall not be Utterly Cast Down.

- APPLICATION: The benefits of having one's steps ordered by the Lord:
  - A life that is under God's guidance and care
    - For Protection --For Preservation
    - For Provisions --For Deliverance
    - For Peace ---For Vindication
  - A life that has spiritual fellowship and satisfaction with the Lord
  - A life that is victorious in the Lord, in spite of any tribulation or trial in life

# • BENEFIT #2: WANTS THAT ARE NEVER ABANDONED BY THE LORD IN A TIME OF NEED (37:25-26)

- OBSERVATION #1: "I have not seen the righteous forsaken."
  - Note carefully: He did not say that the righteous do not and will not experience affliction (I.e., that would be a false statement).
  - Point: He is saying that the righteous are never forsaken by God, no matter what affliction he suffers in this present life (e.g., Rom.8:31-39).

- OBSERVATION #2: "I have not seen the descendants (children) of the righteous begging bread."
  - Note carefully: He did not say that the children of the righteous would be as godly or as prosperous as their parents (I.e., that would be a false statement).
  - Point: He is saying that the children of the righteous are never forsaken by God--even during times of famine and hardship.
- OBSERVATION #3: He (I.e., the righteous) is ever merciful and lends.
  - The righteous are kind, gracious, compassionate, and generous to others.
  - This attitude builds relationships with others, builds a good family reputation, causes kindness to be received in return from others, and affects one's children and grandchildren with a godly example to follow.

### APPLICATION: The benefits of never being abandoned by the Lord

- When you show compassion toward others, the Lord will never forsake you in the time of affliction.
- When you show kindness to others in a time of need, the Lord will cause others to show kindness to you in return in a time of need.
- When you show kindness to others in a time of need, you set a good, godly example for your children and your grand-children.

# • BENEFIT #3: A WELFARE THAT IS PRESERVED SECURE AND ETERNAL BY THE LORD (37:27-33)

- THE EXHORTATION: Depart from evil and do good
  - Depart from evil: Depart from injustice, oppression, acts of unkindness, hatred and spite against others.
  - Do good: Be just, merciful, kind, compassionate, loving towards others.
  - Result: You will dwell forevermore (n. the KJV has this as a command, but it's really a resultant promise).

- -THE REASONS FOR THE EXHORTATION: The Lord loves Justice.
  - Fact #1: The Lord does not forsake His saints.
  - Fact #2: The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom (i.e., his heart is influenced by the Word of God)
  - Fact #3: The Lord will vindicate His people.


- APPLICATION: The benefits of being preserved by the Lord
  - You will have assurance that you will inherit the eternal kingdom with Christ.
  - You will be influenced by the Word of God--your thoughts, your words, your feelings, your attitudes, your choices, your actions, your character.
  - You will be delivered and vindicated from the scrutiny, criticism and personal attacks of the wicked

# SERMON CHALLENGE: IT PAYS TO TRUST IN THE LORD!
