# EXPECATION FROM TRUSTING THE LORD

#### A Question for You

- Does it really pay to trust in the LORD?
- Follow-up question: Why is it so hard to trust the Lord
  - May be it is because we believe that He takes to long to do something.
  - May be it is because we believe that He does not really care.
  - May be it is because we believe that we have to take care of our own problems without God's help.

 LESSON: Real blessings can be realized from trusting in the Lord.



### TRUSTINGLORD and do good; Dwell "the land and cultivate faithfulness. Delight And He will give you heart. Commit your way to the LORD, Trustalsoin Him. and He will doit. Psalm 37:3-5

- EXPECTATION #1: AN INHERITANCE FROM THE LORD (37:34-36)
  - The Exhortation: Wait on the LORD and keep His
     Way
    - Waiting on the Lord does NOT mean you are doing nothing at all—it means that you are trusting God to act on your behalf in His own time.
    - Waiting on the Lord and keeping His Way go hand-in-hand—keeping His way means that you obey God's command in all situations, even when you are tempted to do the wrong thing to get what you want or to get something done now.

#### – The Promise: He shall exalt you

- To be exalted means to be elevated or raised up to a position of honor, respect, and esteem, and to receive special privileges
- This has two special privileges
  - You will be exalted to inherit the land, i.e., God will give you a time of peace, safety, prosperity, and joy in this life and in His kingdom
  - You will be exalted through vindication, i.e., you will see justice dealt out to the wicked—in this life and in the judgment day.

#### - The Confirmation:

- The wicked may have a successful start
- Nevertheless, the wicked will have a terrible end

## • EXPECTATION #2: A LIFE OF SECURE PEACE FROM THE LORD (37:37-40)

- The Exhortation: Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright
  - A blameless man is one who has a good public testimony and reputation (note: pastors are suppose to have a good public testimony)
  - Note: Look around you and notice how God works in the life of the man or woman who trust in Him!
    - Doesn't God meet their needs?
    - Doesn't God protect and vindicate them?
    - Doesn't God give them strength, courage, and confidence in tough times?
    - —Doesn't God give them a measure of peace, joy, happiness, and satisfaction?

- The Promise: The future of that man is peace
  - Peace with God
  - Peace with others
  - Peace within: Inner safety, security, and satisfaction
- The Confirmation: The salvation of the righteous is from the LORD
  - He is their strength in the time of trouble
  - He will help them and deliver and vindicate them from the wicked



- **3. Affirm** that the Lord Jesus Christ is your Lord and Saviour by **receiving** His provision of salvation through your faith in Him alone.
