DON'T LIVE FOR RICHES ALONE PSALM 49







AN OBSERVATION

- There is nothing wrong or sinful with being rich and enjoying the good things in life.
- However: It is futile to live only for the things of this life (i.e., possessions, power, position, privilege, status, and fame), in light of the certainty of death and eternity.
- Luke 12:15: And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses."
- Sermon Lesson: Our focus in life should not be on getting things in this life, but on a life of eternity with God.

- Psalm 49 has three major sections that unify to show us why it is important to focus on eternity with God instead of possession of earthly things.
 - **—THE UNIVERSAL CALL 49:1-4**
 - **—THE UNIQUE COUNSEL 49:5-15**
 - -THE UNDENIABLE CONCLUSION 49:16-20

THE UNIVERSAL CALL 49:1-4

• THE INVITATION 49:1-2

 Point: Here is a message that is universal for all people of all races and cultures, in all places, and for all ages (past, present, and future).

THE INTENTION 49:3-4

 Point: The goal of this universal message is to is to give some practical wisdom so that one can live wisely (I.e., not foolishly) in the sight of God

THE UNIQUE COUNSEL 49:5-15

• THE QUESTION EXAMINED 49:5

- Point: Why should I worry or become fearful, stressed out, frustrated and depressed when I come under attack by wicked people (e.g., through ridicule, hostile criticism, physical abuse, verbal abuse, oppression, injustice, persecution or any kind of mistreatment)?
- Special Note: Part of living this earthly life (no matter how rich you may become) is enduring some kind of attack from evil people--we can either be victorious over it, or be defeated by it.

• THE ANSWER EXPLAINED 49:6-12

- Answer #1: Wealth has limitations 49:6-9
 - What it cannot purchase: Redemption for anyone's life
 - What it cannot perceive: That a soul (i.e., life) is very costly (i.e., it cannot be purchase with anything a man has).
 - What it cannot prevent: It cannot prevent anyone from going to the Pit (i.e., the place of the dead).
- Answer #2: Life has termination 49:10-12
 - What all men see: That all men die
 - What all men think: That their wealth will last forever
 - What all men experience: Death like the beasts (i.e., the ultimate humiliation)

• THE CONTRAST EXPLORED 49:13-15

- The Delusion of the foolish 49:13-14
 - **Point:** Those who are foolish, and those who approve of their way, trust in and live for riches—forgetting about the certainty of death and eternity.
- The Destiny of the Faithful 49:15
 - Point: The faithful knows that he will die (i.e., both the
 wise and the fool and the senseless person dies); but he
 also knows that he will rise again from the dead and live
 with the Lord!

THE UNDENIABLE CONCLUSION 49:16-20

THE EXHORTATION 49:16

 Point: It is foolish to be jealous of or intimidated by the prosperity of others, esp. the ungodly (e.g., you do not have to keep up with the Jones).

THE EXPLANATION 49:17-19

 Point: When someone dies he shall carry nothing away; his glory shall not descend after him (e.g., no matter how rich, how powerful, how privileged, how famous, or how influential he may be)

THE EPILOGUE 49:20

 Point: How you understand this message will determine if you live a life of hope or futility!

A CHALLENGE FOR YOU

- DOES YOUR LIFE ONLY CONSIST IN THE ABUNDANCE OF THE THINGS YOU POSSESS?
 - Do you live only for your job, business or career?
 - Do you live only to make money?
 - Do you live only to buy material things
 - Isn't there anything more to life than things?

RECEIVE THE LORD JESUS CHRIST AS YOUR SAVIOUR TODAY!!





- Acknowledge that the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, <u>died</u> on the cross for your sin, and that He <u>arose</u> again from the dead on the third day.
- 2. Admit that you are a sinner, guilty of sin and responsible and accountable to a holy God for your sin, and that you are under His just condemnation and eternal punishment for your sin.
- **3. Affirm** that the Lord Jesus Christ is your Lord and Saviour by **receiving** His provision of salvation through your faith in Him alone.
