## THE ASSURANCE OF ANSWERED PRAYER


1 John 5:14-15

# The Christian life is a life of assurance, Not doubt, Not fear, Not uncertainty.

- A Christian knows the truth (1John 2:21), and can distinguish the spirit of truth and the spirit of error (1John 4:2,6).
- A Christian knows the Lord (1John 2:3) and knows that the Lord abides in Him (1John2:5; 3:4) and that he abides in the Lord (1John4:13).
- A Christian knows that when Christ is revealed, he shall be like Him, for he shall see Him as He is (1John 3:2)
- A Christian knows that he has passed from death to life (1John 3:14), and that he has eternal life (1John5:13)

# A Believer in Christ can know that God will respond to his/her prayer request!

## THE BIG QUESTION What gives a believer confidence that God will respond to his/her prayers?





### There are three important Acknowledgements that give confidence for answered prayer

- Acknowledgement #1: The Knowledge that what we ask for is in <u>accordance with God's will</u>
- Acknowledgement #2: The knowledge that God hears us favorably
- Acknowledgement #3: The knowledge that God will grant the requests that are asked of Him

## The Knowledge that what we ask for is in <u>Accordance</u> with God's Will

- THE TEXT: "If we ask anything according to His will, He hears us."
- **THE PROBLEM:** Most of our prayers are selfish prayers.
- THE ISSUE: Prayer is a mighty instrument, NOT for getting man's will done in heaven, but for getting God's will done on earth!

I THINK I NEED TO SET UP A SPAM FILTER TO CATCH LOTTERY PRAYER REQUESTS

- THE QUESTION: How can we know that we are asking for something in accordance with the will of God?
  - Does it agree with the written Word of God?
  - Is it expedient, that is, is it helpful?
    - Does it meet a real need or is it for selfish personal gratification?
    - Does it encourage, strengthen, help, and edify others, or does it provoke them to anger or cause them to stumble?
  - Will it bring glory to God publicly before men?

#### The Knowledge that God Hears us <u>Favorably</u>

- THE TEXT: "If we ask anything according to His will, <u>He hears us</u>."
- THE CONFIDENCE: If our request are in accordance with God's revealed will, God will hear us.
- THE PROBLEM: Many of us are praying, but God is NOT responding to our prayers!!

- THE QUESTION: How can we know that God hears us when we pray?
  - Is the prayer in agreement with the Word of God?
  - —Are we keeping His commandments with a clear conscious, or are we living in blatant sin?
  - Are we abiding in Christ, that is living in fellowship with Him unhindered by unconfessed sin?
  - Are we praying with a repentant attitude?

When we pray, God hears more than we say, answers more than we ask, gives more than we imagine... in HIS own time and HIS own way.

## The Knowledge that God will <u>Grant</u> the Request that are asked of Him

- THE TEXT: "And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him."
- THE PROBLEM: Many of us subconsciously have unrealistic expectations of God in prayer.
  - Some of us think that God should respond immediately to our prayers.
  - Some of us think that God should suspend or reverse the laws of nature or the cycle of life and death for us.
  - Some of us think that God should do whatever we tell
     Him to do

- THE QUESTION: How can we know that God will grant our prayer request?
  - Is it something in accordance with the revealed will of God?
  - Was it asked for in faith?
  - Is it something that is helpful or beneficial to others?
  - Is it something that will bring public glory to God?
  - Illustration: Paul asked God to take a thorn in the flesh away. But that thorn in the flesh showed that God's strength is made perfect in weakness. Paul's prayer changed—praying that God would be glorified in his physical infirmities. 2Cor.12:7-10

"Our Lord in His teaching regarding prayer never once referred to unanswered prayer; He said God always answers prayer." Oswald Chambers

- Special Note: We spend a lot of time worrying about unanswered prayer.
  - This is because our prayers are selfish and our love and service to God is conditioned upon what God does for us.
- A Christian can know that if he/she ask anything according to God's will, God hears him/her and grant the petition.
  - This implies that the Christian knows what God's will is!!
  - This implies that what the Christian wants is what God wants. The Christian wants what God wants!
  - Illustration: Many Christian are asking God for a spouse (that is selfish). The prayer should be, "make me a loving husband/wife for the welfare of the one I marry, for an example to the saints and the world, for the cause of Christ, for the glory of God.

## Do you have confidence in your prayers

- 1. Acknowledge that the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, <u>died</u> on the cross for your sin, and that He <u>arose</u> again from the dead on the third day.
- 2. Admit that you are a sinner, guilty of sin and responsible and accountable to a holy God for your sin, and that you are under His just condemnation and eternal punishment for your sin.
- **3. Affirm** that the Lord Jesus Christ is your Lord and Saviour by **receiving** His provision of salvation through your faith in Him alone.
